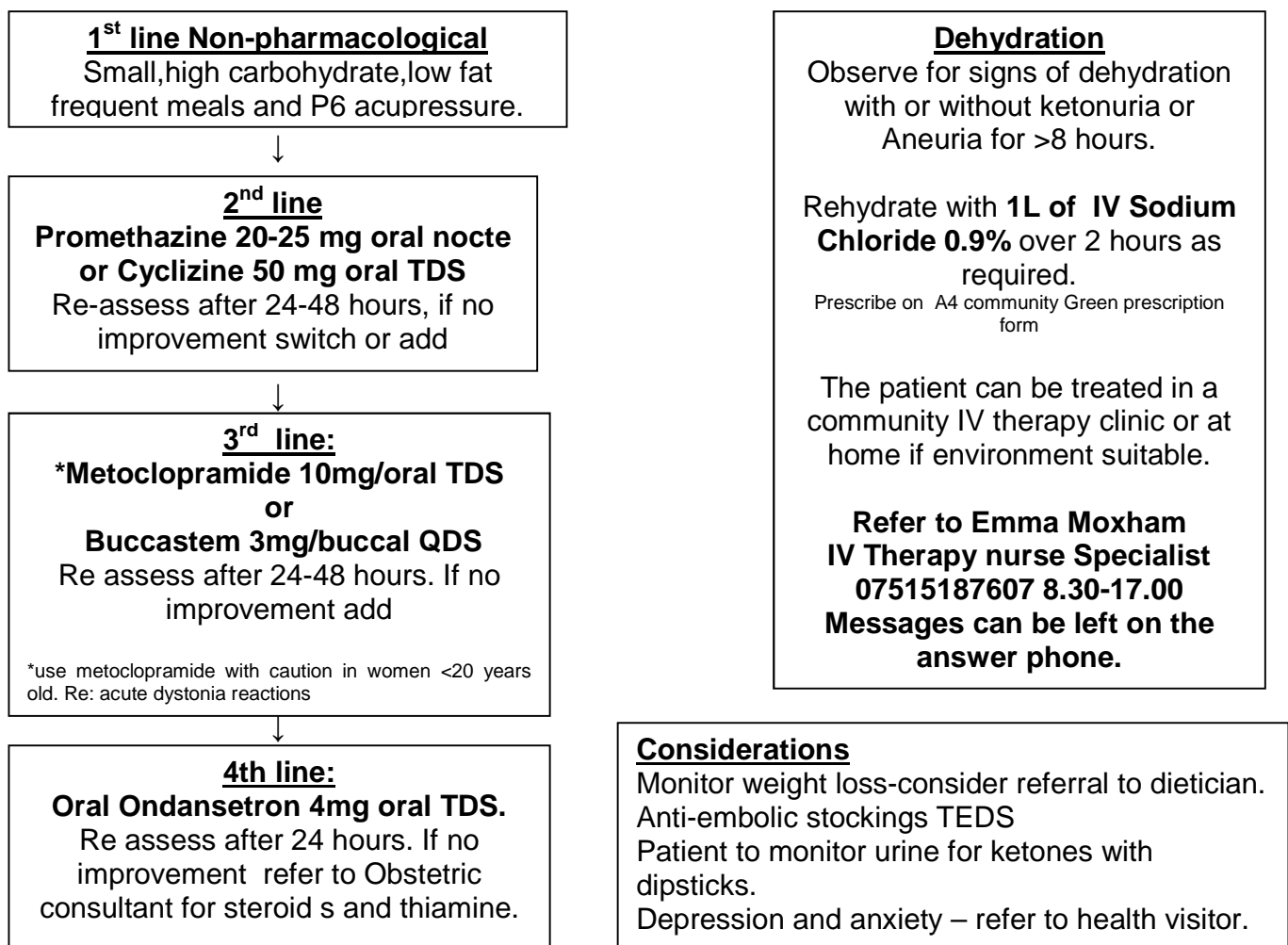


Pregnancy Sickness/Hyperemesis Community Management Pathway

All anti-emetics are unlicensed for the treatment of nausea and vomiting in pregnancy, despite this they are routinely used in the treatment of Hyperemesis Gravidarum. This medication pathway has been developed in line with the Royal United Hospital's hyperemesis guidelines and has been approved by Mr David Walker Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist- Royal United Hospital, Bath.
